St John provides a safe place for Youth Members to learn, have fun and feel positive about being a member of St John.

Adult members of St John will always work with you in a way that is safe and respectful. St John will not tolerate any behaviour by an adult or child that puts the safety of a Youth Member at risk.

If you are worried about your safety or the safety of someone else, you can tell a trusted St John adult—they will listen and take action to help you.

- be safe
- be treated fairly and with respect
- ask questions or for help
- talk when you feel angry, upset, worried or unsafe
- be listened to and believed
- feel like a valued member of St John.

## DO...

## YOUR RESPONSIBILITIES

- be friendly, helpful and kind
- be truthful
- use good judgement
- tell a trusted adult if you or someone else feels worried or unsafe
- report bullying
- listen to your leaders
- spread positivity!

## DON'T...

- be violent or aggressive
- make someone feel unsafe
- use alcohol or other drugs
- post rude, nasty, untrue, private or embarrassing things online
- damage other people's stuff.
